The First International CRIMHUM Conference was held on February 20-21, 2020 in the glorious city of Lviv. Lviv National University named after Ivan Franko was the host university. The aim of the conference was to draw attention to the Erasmus+ CRIMHUM project and its interim results, as well as to discuss issues of modern legal education in the field of criminal justice.

On March 31, 2020, a registration card of the project "Modernisation of master programmes for future judges, prosecutors, investigators with respect to European standard on human rights" (CRIMHUM) was signed in the Secretariat of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine. Thus, from this date, the project is considered registered as international technical assistance in Ukraine.

So since March 31, 2020, the activities carried out within the framework of the project in Ukraine fall under the legislation on international technical assistance and the project is recognized by the state.

Technical Report is coming

July 15, 2020 is the medium of the CRIMHUM project. Our project has gone through many things: registration thorns and coronavirus spikes. However, the CRIMHUM team believes that by the middle of the project we came up with a definite result and from September 1, 2020, in all 5 universities of Belarus and Ukraine, **masters will start classes on a modernized program in the field of criminal justice**. This will be the core of our Project Technical Report.

First Coordination Meeting
