### Online lectures of EU experts

Within the framework of the CRIMHUM project, lectures were provided by experts from universities of the Member States of the European Union for master-students from universities in Belarus and Ukraine.

This activity pursues two goals in the project:  
1) a master-class for teachers from universities in Belarus and Ukraine,  
2) familiarization of master students with foreign (European) experience in the field of criminal law and procedure.

Of course, the consortium, when drawing up the workplan in 2018, did not know what the world expects in 2020. However, already at that time the lectures were scheduled online, which made it possible to carry them out on time in accordance with the workplan.

The first slot of lectures was delivered to Belarusian and Ukrainian master-students from November 2020 to March 2021. Almost all lectures were delivered in English. Lecturers entered into discussions with students.


The cycle of lectures was opened by **Prof. Dr. Thomas Krüßmann** (University of Graz) at **Yaroslav Mudryi National Law University**. In addition, lectures were given by **Katerina Soulou** and **Dr. Natasa Danelciuc-Colodrovschi** (Aix-Marseille University), **Associate Professor of Practice Gintaras Jasaitis** (Vilnius University). The role of the host teacher was also important. She (he) needed to prepare students

for the information that would be given at the lectures of the European expert, and when working in the classroom, moderation of the lesson was also required (if necessary, clarification of some issues from the point of view of national approaches). In connection with the extension of the project, we expect to continue the practice of online lectures in the next academic year.

### Students get-together

Another format of online activity was not originally planned in the project. It was proposed by the **project manager Professor Thomas Krüßmann** in connection with the transition of all trainings to the online format.

This format was named **students get-together**. On Saturdays, in some months, students from all partner universities from Belarus and Ukraine had the opportunity to communicate with a professor from one of the EU universities. During the online-meetings, overview was given about studying in the relevant EU state and the peculiarities of the university, which was represented by the professor. Students could ask questions.

First online-meeting of **CRIMHUM** students was organised within **Erasmus+ Days 2020**. Project manager Professor Thomas Krüßmann was the key speaker.

### 2<sup>nd</sup> monitoring visit

On March 30, the National Erasmus+ Office in Belarus monitored the CRIMHUM project. This is the second project monitoring in Belarus. The host organisation was the Yanka Kupala State University of Hrodna.

### WP 2

The authors teams continue to work on the content of the course books in consultation with European colleagues. The manuscripts of three books are ready in Belarus, one manuscript – in Ukraine.

Belarusian specialists, together with European and Ukrainian experts, have modernised the syllabi of such disciplines as criminal law, criminal procedure, criminology (for undergraduate students).

### WP 5

The admission campaign 2021 is starting in Belarus and Ukraine.

### WP6

The quality manager ensures the quality of the project on a daily basis. Each course book is assessed by QM and at least by two extern experts in the appropriate sphere. Each course book will have official permission for publishing in Belarus.
